



Moorlands Primary School Safeguarding Statement



Moorlands Primary School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and expects all staff, visitors and volunteers to share this commitment.

Safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children is defined as:

- protecting children from maltreatment;
- preventing impairment of children's mental and physical health or development;
- ensuring that children grow up in circumstances consistent with the provision of safe and effective care; and
- taking action to enable all children to have the best outcomes.

We have a number of policies and procedures in place that contribute to our safeguarding commitment, including our Child Protection policy, Emotional and Well-Being policy, Online Safety policy and PHSE policy .

We provide emotional and well-being support for pupils through our partnership with Murray Hall.

Sometimes we may need to share information and work in partnership with other agencies when there are concerns about a child's welfare. We will ensure that our concerns about our pupils are discussed with his/her parents/carers first unless we have reason to believe that such a move would be contrary to the child's welfare.

We actively support the Government's Prevent Agenda to counter radicalism and extremism.
