Important Information

Children under the age of 8 years old **must** be accompanied at all times in the pool by a responsible adult of at least 16 years of age. One adult may accompany a maximum of 2 children under the age of 8 years old.

Staff will be available to support you during the family swim but are unable to offer personal assistance when changing.

The Centre's lockers require a £1.00 coin to operate but is returned when the locker is opened and the hairdryers are free.

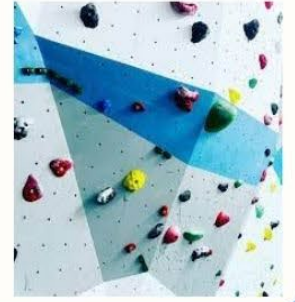
