



Year 1	Summer Term
Reading stimulus	
<p>Within English, we shall be focusing on <i>The Gingerbread Man</i> and <i>The Three Little Pigs</i>. This text will give us lots of opportunities for hands-on inspiration for our creative writing as well as non-fiction genres such as exploring how to use a dictionary. We will continue focussing on our letter formation through the use of regular handwriting sessions.</p>	
Maths	
<p>In Mathematics we will be developing our number knowledge by furthering understanding of our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will be applying this knowledge to solve related multiplication and division facts. We will be learning what a half and a quarter is, as well as learning to tell the time and work with money. We will also learn about place value up to 100.</p>	
Science	
<p>In Science will be looking at plants through sorting and classifying; making close observations; identifying plant types, identifying parts of plants and role playing the role of a botanist. We shall also be planting our own sunflowers.</p>	
Geography / History	
<p>In History we will be completing our research on significant people such as Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and Emmeline Pankhurst. In Geography, children will be developing their knowledge of the local area where they will explore their local area, use maps and simple compass directions. There will also be a focus on exploring continents in finding out where our favourite animals live.</p>	
R.E.	
<p>In R.E. We will complete our focus on Sikhism and begin to focus and learn about Islam. We will also learn about what it means to belong to a Faith Community.</p>	
Art	
<p>Our Topic in Art will be Colour Splash. We will be learning about primary and secondary colours, colour mixing techniques and applying these skills in painting and printing.</p>	
Design Technology	
<p>We will be considering where our food comes from and designing, making and evaluating our own smoothie.</p>	
P.E.	
<p>PE sessions shall be on Tuesday afternoons and children will develop invasion game skills working with the Albion Foundation. Children will also develop their athletic skills. Please can you ensure that all earrings and jewellery are removed for this session.</p>	
Music	
<p>In Music, we will be exploring pitch by identifying high and low notes and combining different pitches to compose a simple superhero melody.</p>	
Computing	
<p>This term Year 1 will be creating media digital writing. We will be identifying and writing labels and properties of objects/shape; grouping and counting and comparing and answering questions. We then move onto Programming Animations using Scratch where we will learn how to find and use commands to move a sprite.</p>	
Jigsaw	
<p>The value for this term is Perseverance. Children will be learning about showing determination in every task that we do and to never give up. Our Jigsaw sessions will look at 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me'.</p>
